

## **NOTICE 9 OF 2019**

ALTERNATIVE ADMINISTRATIVE DESCRIPTION FOR DIRECTORS OF COMPANIES AND MEMBERS OF CLOSE CORPORATIONS WHERE COMPANY OR CLOSE CORPORATION IS FINALLY DEREGISTERED

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC), in an effort to present information on the Companies Registry in a more understandable manner, will be implementing an alternative administrative description for directors of companies (directors) and members of close corporations (members) where the company or close corporation was finally deregistered.

As from 4 February 2019, directors and members who were active in such position at the time of final deregistration, will reflect an "inactive" status on the CIPC website <a href="www.cipc.co.za">www.cipc.co.za</a> and CIPC certificates and documents. Upon re-instatement of the company or close corporation, the director or member status will revert back to an "active" status.

It must be noted that the "inactive" status of directors and members, is not a legal description but rather an administrative description created by CIPC in the reflection of information as per the Companies Registry. Therefore, an "inactive" status on the CIPC website and/or documents generated by CIPC does not limit, restrict or negate in any way the legal effect of section 83(2) and (3) of the Companies Act, 71 of 2008 or any other provision within such Act or the Close Corporations Act, 69 of 1984 regarding the duties, liabilities or responsibilities of directors and members.
